
READ THE COMMAND: IN MATTHEW 22:37-39, JESUS SAYS...

WHAT DOES THIS PASSAGE TELL US ABOUT GOD?

- God desires to be loved by all of who we are (heart, soul, strength, and mind (v.27)).
- God desires that we love our neighbors as ourselves (v.27).
- Important to note: In this story Jesus uses a Samaritan as the one who showed mercy to the man who was beaten. Samaritans were hated by the Jews. Samaritan's were considered unclean. He was speaking to the Israelite Jews saying that if the Samaritans can be the loving neighbor, where does that lead them?

WHAT DOES THIS PASSAGE TELL US ABOUT PEOPLE?

- We are to love God fully (heart, soul, strength & mind V.27)
- We are to love our neighbor as ourselves (V.27)
- We are to have compassion on those in need (V.33)
- We are to show mercy to those in need (V.37)

ARE THERE ANY SINS IN THE PASSAGE TO AVOID?

• The command is to LOVE your neighbor as yourself...so anything short of that!

ARE THERE ANY PROMISES IN THE PASSAGE THAT WE SHOULD BEHOLD?

• IF WE LOVE THE LORD WITH ALL OF OUR HEART, SOUL, STRENGTH & MIND AND WE LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS OURSELVES YOU WILL LIVE (V.27-28)

• To love the Lord your God with all of your heart, soul, strength & mind and to love your neighbor as yourself.

- John 13:34-45, Because Jesus loved us first. Love teaches the world about Jesus.

D. HOW DO WE LOVE?

- John 14:15 - Loving Jesus means we obey him. John 21:17- Loving others means telling them what God has done for you
