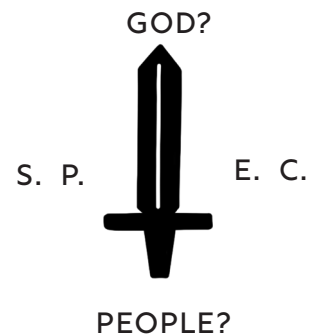
**READ THE COMMAND:** IN JOHN 13:13-17, JESUS SAYS...
